HALLOWEEN GUIDELINES

This year Lazar Middle School will recognize Halloween by allowing students to wear appropriate costumes to school. Students should be informed of these guidelines. Those participating in dress-up will be asked to make a minimum donation of one dollar (\$1.00) to UNICEF. Builders Club members will place UNICEF collection boxes in all classrooms.

It is important to remember that appropriate school behavior is expected on Halloween Day and that inappropriate behavior will result in a loss of privilege to participate.

The following guidelines will be in effect:

1. Dress-up for students and teachers will take place on **Friday, October 31.** Dressing-up for Halloween is optional for both students and teachers.
2. Costumes should be:
 - a. Practical and Safe - Students should be able to work at their desks and move throughout the building without being physically inhibited or a hazard to anyone.
 - b. Respectful/Not Controversial - They should not be offensive to a gender, nationality, race, or religious group.
 - c. Modest - Students must wear costumes that cover themselves and adhere to the dress code.
3. Masks may not be worn. Hats may be worn if they are part of the costume, but should be removed during class time.
4. Students are not permitted to bring props of any kind to school.
5. All make-up should be applied at home. **No make-up or hair spray should be brought to school.**
6. There will be no organized parties or a change in schedule on Halloween.
7. No rollerblades, skateboards, or bicycles are allowed in school.
