The Administrative Team will develop goal statements for each of the four areas identified. These goals will be presented to the Board for discussion and adoption. Goals will hopefully be adopted at the August 25th meeting but no later than the September 8th meeting.

- 7) *pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation and/or matters of attorney-client privilege*

8) specific prospective or current employees unless all who could be adversely affected request an open session

9) deliberation after a public hearing that could result in a civil penalty or other loss.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Montville Township Board of Education will meet in public session on July 28, 2015 at 7:30 pm at Montville Township Municipal Building.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the minutes of this closed session be made public when the need for confidentiality no longer exists.
