WHEREAS, the Montville Township Board of Education desires to employ René T. Rovtar as its Superintendent of Schools; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Rovtar has agreed to serve as Superintendent of Schools; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Montville Township Board of Education does hereby appoint René T. Rovtar as its Superintendent of Schools, effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018, at an annual salary of \$167,500.00, and subject to the remaining terms and conditions of the Contract of Employment, including merit increases as provided for by Code; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Dr. Rovtar’s employment is subject to the terms and conditions of a Contract of Employment that has been approved by the County Superintendent and which is hereby approved by the Montville Township Board of Education; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board President and Board Secretary are authorized and directed to execute the aforesaid Contract of Employment on behalf of the Montville Township Board of Education.
