- Woodmont - Thank you to Officer Scott McGowan from the Montville Police Department for presenting two safety assemblies on Monday, October 19, 2015 in honor of School Violence and vandalism Awareness Week. Officer McGowan shared a "stranger danger" assembly for grades K-2 and a cyberbullying assembly for grades 3-5. Officer McGowan had every student sign an Anti-Bullying pledge at the end of the assembly.
- Woodmont - The Second Graders of Woodmont are learning lots in Social Studies. They have been learning about the United States branches of government, responsibilities of citizens, and the different aspects of community. They celebrated all things American on their Tasty Traveling Tuesday adventure. The children shared places they have visited around the country and tasted favorite American treats like pigs in a blanket, apple pie with vanilla ice cream, hamburger sliders, hot dogs, corn dogs, popcorn and potato chips.

During our lunch periods, we had members of the Morris County Sheriff’s Dept. come speak to the students about school violence, how to prevent it and what to do when it happens. Officer Balkis Bernard did an amazing job delivering her message and the students lined up to speak with her afterwards. Officer Mike Puzio and Undersheriff William Schievella joined her in meeting with the students.
