





# Montville's Plan

- The district Reopening Plan was approved by the Board of Education on August 8<sup>th</sup>
- The district received a communication from the Morris Executive County Superintendent indicating that the plan addressed all of NJDOE review criteria
- What we did not have on August 8<sup>th</sup> was the total number of staff requesting accommodations and students requesting full-time remote instruction



# Changes to the Plan Middle and High School

- At the middle and high school levels combined we have 19 teachers who have requested accommodations
- In order to facilitate teachers teaching from home, a substitute must be provided to supervise the in-person students.
- At the present time we have not been able to secure an adequate number of substitute teachers to handle these assignments while still having an adequate number of substitutes available for the regular daily absences that occur.

# Instructional Plan Elementary Schools

## Cedar Hill, Hilldale, Valley View, William Mason and Woodmont Elementary Schools

- Due to the larger than expected numbers of full-time remote students at the elementary level –
- Elementary classes will be configured on a “home school” basis
- NO cross district full-time remote classes
- Full-time remote students will stream into their assigned in-person class
- Two adults assigned to each classroom to facilitate instruction





# High School Athletics

- ▶ As long as the NJSIAA does not cancel the fall sports season, our intent is to continue to run the fall athletic programs in accordance with the NJSIAA guidelines



# A Summary Statement

- Middle and High School Open September 8<sup>th</sup> will full-time remote for all students
- To be re-evaluated October 15<sup>th</sup> for expected return to in-person instruction at Middle and High School on Nov. 2
- In-person instruction for Pre-K through 5 begins September 8<sup>th</sup> – Monday/Tuesday/Thursday/Friday + Virtual Wednesday
- K-5 Full-Time Remote students will stream into their assigned classroom at their home school
