Community

Montville Township, a suburban community of 21,058 in Morris County, New Jersey, lies 34 miles from New York City. In 2020, Montville was ranked 75 in *Niche.com's* Top 100 Places to Live in NJ and 114 in NJ Monthly Magazine's Top Places to Live in 2019. OneMontville, an award-winning community program recognized by Character.org, originated in Montville Township Public Schools. It is now a stand-alone non-profit community organization that promotes acceptance, respect, and kindness. This community-wide initiative is supported by Montville Township's businesses, clergy, elected officials, parents, teachers, administrators, students, and others.

District

In 2018, the Montville Township School District was selected as a National District of Character by Character.org. In addition, six district schools have been named National Schools of Character. In 2021, the district was nationally recognized for the sixth straight year by the NAMM Foundation as a Best Community for Music Education. In 2020-2021, the district ranked 35 in *Niche.com's* Top 100 School Districts. As of 2020, all seven Montville Township Schools were recertified as having attained Bronze Level Certification through Sustainable Jersey for Schools.

School

Montville Township High School is a comprehensive, four-year public school with a current enrollment of 265 seniors out of 1,082 students. MTHS values its 10:1 student-teacher ratio. The majority of the faculty holds at least one advanced degree. MTHS offers over 39 co-curricular activities in addition to 27 varsity athletic teams. The vast majority of our students are actively engaged in our school and broader community.

In 2020, Montville Township High School was ranked 84 in New Jersey High Schools by *U.S. News* and won the 2020 College Success Award from GreatSchools.org. *New Jersey Monthly Magazine* ranked Montville Township High School #18 on their biennial listing of the Top 100 New Jersey Public High Schools in 2018. In 2021, the National Speech and Debate Association included MTHS on its list of the Top 100 Schools in the USA. MTHS also achieved Bronze Cyber Opportunity School status from CyberStart America.

Curriculum Highlights

MTHS offers over 175 courses that include:

- 23 Advanced Placement classes in both core academic subjects and the arts, and a rigorous Honors program offering 34 classes;
- 9 Middle College classes where students earn college credit;
- an Independent Study Program; and
- Electives in the Visual/Performing Arts, 21st Century Technology, Life/Career Skills, and Financial Literacy.
- The 3-year Science Research Program, offers sophomore students the opportunity to participate in self-selected, authentic research in natural or social science. Each summer, students participate in an internship project with a mentor from a professional research institution.
- Nationally recognized by District Administration, the Humanities Research Program engages students in the process of combining student conducted research with end-product creation and leadership development.

Highlights of Student Achievements

Academic

- 1 National Merit Scholar, 13 National Merit Finalists, 13 Semi-Finalists, 68 Commended Students, and 2 students received the National Merit Corporate Scholarship over the last 3 years.
- 1 student awarded AP International Diploma, 45 awarded AP Scholar with Distinction, 17 awarded AP Scholar with Honor, and 21 awarded AP Scholar
- □ 8 students earned the Seal of Biliteracy; 2 earning it by mastering two languages in addition to English in 2021.

Extracurricular

- ☐ The Forensics team was ranked among the Top 1% in schools nationwide. They enjoyed continued success at multiple national tournaments in 2021, including students qualifying and placing for the National Speech and Debate Tournament in 10 categories. The team also placed 3rd in the State of New Jersey.
- A "Group Performance" team and an MTHS student "Individual Website" advanced from the NJ State History Competition to the Washington D.C. National History Day Competition hosted by the University of Maryland.
- □ The Marching Band was highly rated in the Tournament of Band Competitions.
- □ Four students were awarded top prizes at the Wallkill Regional High School Art Show. Those awards were 1st place Drawing, 1st & 2nd place Pottery and 1st place Digital Media.
- □ Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) competed in the 2021 NJ State Leadership Conference earning 4th place in the Outstanding Chapter competition. Individual/Team competitors took home three 2nd place trophies, four 4th place trophies, and two 5th place trophies. Additionally, 23 students competed in the National Leadership Conference in a variety of events.


