Good News & Progress in Our Schools:

A proposal submitted by Cesar Cruz and Anthony Sia, teachers at MTHS, has been accepted for the creation of a MTHS documentary on the School of Rock and how it affects the high school and the Montville Township community. This film will be featured at the 2018 Sonic Highways Hometown Documentaries Film Festival will be part of the New Jersey School Boards Association's Fall Workshop in October.

On May 5th students from MTHS competed in the New Jersey History Day State Competition at William Paterson University. In the Group Website category Hannah Park and Kelly Chan qualified for the National Competition in Washington, D.C. Cameron

Hojecki, Sarah Bolen and Victoria Wei were National Alternates for their Group Documentary. Congratulations to these students and best of luck at Nationals in June!

Congratulations to Woodmont School for having their Pathways Peer Mentoring Program selected as a 2018 Promising Practice by Character. org.

- Hilldale: The students at Hilldale did an outstanding job celebrating the 30th Anniversary of Project ACES (All Children Exercise Simultaneously)! Led by Mr. Schwindel, each grade got an opportunity to lead the entire school in some of our favorite exercises and warmup activities. Congratulations to Len Saunders on 30 years of this wonderful event!
- Valley View - Once again celebrated the 30th anniversary of Project ACES or All Children Exercise Simultaneously. On May 2, the entire student population and staff, along with Dr. Rovtar and Mr. Guarino went outside to exercise together. Millions of children from all 50 states and dozens of countries exercised together to promote a healthy lifestyle. NJTV and the USA Today Network also came to the school. The program was organized by the school PE teacher, Mr. Saunders.
- Valley View - The Kindergarten students at Valley View are starting to learn about the butterfly life cycle in science. We ordered caterpillars from Insect Lore so we will be able to observe the caterpillars and their transformation. We have seen how they start so very small and then watch them eat and grow big. We are then able to see how they go to the top of the container and make their "j shape" which is the beginning stages of the chrysalis. If we are lucky, we may even be able to see a caterpillar transform into the chrysalis. Once the beautiful butterflies hatch, we will take them outside and release them back to nature. This is such a fun and exciting experience!
- Valley View - The classes are also very busy preparing crafts, writing pieces and singing songs for our Annual Mother's Day Tea which will be next Wednesday, May 9th.
- William Mason - Held its annual Special Persons Day event on May 4th. Students were able to share their school with the special people in their lives. It s a fun day for the students to display their work, show odd their classroom, and to introduce those special to them to their friends and teachers. It was a great day and one that we enjoy.
- William Mason - The students in Mrs. Oberlin's Class at William Mason School have been learning about metamorphosis! We ordered larvae from *Insect Lore* and received our mini caterpillars two days later! We learned that our new friends started from eggs by reading several books about the lifecycle of a butterfly! We worked together at our tables to come up with names for our five caterpillars. The names were: Sparkle, Chicka, Frankie, Twisty, and Swirly! We watched them grow into huge caterpillars! Next, we observed how they transformed into the chrysalis stage! Lastly, our butterflies emerged from the chrysalis! We were so excited! We recorded each lifecycle stage in our observational journal! We will soon be making "butterfly hats" and having a butterfly releasing ceremony.
- William Mason - Mrs. Stella's students learned about Fables and created their won stories revolving around a moral lesson.
- William Mason - Mrs. Stella's students observed plants and how they can erode land. They later Conducted experiments to see the effects of water and wind on soil and rocks.
- Lazar - The TV Studio at Lazar Middle School has finally entered the 21st century! A total digital upgrade was installed over Spring Break, moving the studio overnight from analog VCR technology to digital HDMI. Green screen chroma key technology has been added, allowing the students to broadcast from "anywhere". This technology was put in full force on May 4th, when Lazar's First Fun Friday theme was "May the Fourth Be With You", and the LNN broadcast team was able to broadcast from the Death Star, have a light saber duel between anchors and our guest Storm Trooper (Mrs. Chelsea Stebbins) in a far away galaxy, and the song of the day included the video of the Cantina Star Wars Scene. Other upgrades to the Lazar TV Studio include a computer graphics program, a teleprompter, an enhanced audio system, studio lighting, communication equipment to connect the studio with the control room, and television studio-grade digital cameras. The students and their teacher, Jeanne Matuszewski, are enjoying the challenges of learning and implementing the new technologies into the TV Studio Program, bringing improved broadcast programming each morning to the Lazar community.
- Lazar - Ms. Matuszewski and all of Lazar send a big thank you to Director of Information Technology Services, Austin Thomsen and Information Technology Services Support Specialist, Jeffrey Bonicioli, for their efforts in bringing about the creation of a new TV Studio experience for all of our students.
- Lazar - Jeanne Matuszewski, Lazar Middle School TV Studio Production teacher, has been invited to appear in the 25th Anniversary Special for Classroom Close-up NJ. The segment will be recorded in late June and aired during the next season. Classroom Close-up NJ is a 15-time Emmy award winning show that features innovative public school projects and it is the only television program in the country devoted to featuring the positive things happening in the public schools in New Jersey. The Lazar Middle School's TV Studio program was first featured in the 2014-2015 season of Classroom Closeup: <http://classroomcloseup.org/segments/lazar-news-network/> Other Lazar programs honored by Classroom Closeup include Mr. Matt Myer's Organic Farming project in the 2015-2016 <http://classroomcloseup.org/segments/organic-farming/> and Ms. Marisa Wos' Stem Pals last year: <http://classroomcloseup.org/segments/stem-pals/>

- Lazar - On Friday, April 27th, Lazar Students, along with millions of other students across the country, were given the opportunity to take a vow of silence to highlight the silencing effects of anti-LGBTQ bullying, harassment, and erasure on LGBTQ students at school. Lazar would like to create a safe place for students to talk, and express themselves freely without being judged.
- Lazar - Congratulations to Cheryl Zanone, on receiving the Fellows Award from the New Jersey Science Teachers Association. The award is presented to recognize an individual who gives the association of their time and talent to a degree not normally expected of them.
- Lazar - Lazar celebrated National Poem in your Pocket Day on April 26. Many staff members carried poems and shared them with each other and their students. Also, many classes focused on poetry in a variety of ways; reading, discussing, and writing reflections and original work. Poetry was moved outside the English classroom and was even discussed in World Language classes and Science classes. This event continues to develop connections through the exploration of poetry!
- Lazar - On Thursday, May 3rd, Mr. Miller and Ms. Scognamiglio’s advisory group at Lazar hosted a prom for Montville's senior citizens. The students in the advisory group greeted the senior citizens in their best 1950s apparel, transformed Lazar's cafeteria into a 1950s diner, served dinner and home-made desserts, and danced the night away along with senior citizens from Montville's Senior House. Mrs. Stebbins's middle school jazz band's music played beautifully during dinner. The senior citizens even put on costumes and had their pictures taken at a photo booth. Both the seniors and students had a great night and made new friendships with each other.
- Lazar - On Thursday, May 10th, the STEP Leadership group, under the guidance of Ms. Barkey and Mrs. Gothelf, orchestrated a “Switcheroo...Sit with Someone New Day”, during all lunch periods. The idea behind the day was to instill in our kids that we are a community and we need to reach out and be friendly to everyone who walks the Lazar halls. Upon entering the cafeteria, all students were given a card that had a shape on it and had to sit at the table that corresponded to that shape. There were activities to do and conversations ensued.

Public Participation (For items on the agenda only)

Section H

The Board of Education recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of allowing members of the public to express themselves on school matters of community interest.

In order to permit the fair and orderly expression of such comments, the Board shall set aside a portion of Board meeting, the length of the portion to be determined by the Board, for public comment on any school district issue that a member of the public feels may be of concern to the residents of the school district.

Public participation shall be governed by the following rules.

1. A participant must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface comments by an announcement of his/her name, municipality of residence, and group affiliation, if applicable;
2. Each statement made by a participant shall be limited to five minutes' duration;
3. No participant may speak more than once on the same topic until all others who wish to speak on that topic have been heard;
4. All statement, questions or inquires shall be directed to the presiding officer and any questions or inquires directed by a participants to another Board member shall be redirected to the presiding officer who shall determine if such statement, question, or inquiry shall be addressed by the presiding officer on behalf of the Board or by the individual Board member;
5. The presiding officer may:
 - Interrupt, warn, and/ or terminate a participant's statement, question or inquiry when it is too lengthy;
 - Interrupt and/or warn a participant when the statement, question or inquiry is abusive, obscene or may be defamatory;
 - Request any person to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum;

- Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that person prevents or disrupts a meeting with an act that obstructs or interferes with a meeting;
- Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting; and
- Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or to maintain an orderly operation of the Board Meeting.
